

## THE REGION WANTS TO TRAIN HEALTH CARE ATTENDANTS AND HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ASSISTANTS

**Baie-Comeau, November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2019** – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de la Côte-Nord joins the vocational training centres in Forestville, Baie-Comeau and Sept-Îles in order to train health care attendants and health and social services assistants.

Those interested are invited to register to the training program in *Assistance à la personne en établissement et à domicile* now. This 870-hour program allows developing skills in this field by combining theoretical and on-the-job training in collaboration with the CISSS de la Côte-Nord.

Seventeen \$7,500 scholarships are available for those enrolled in full-time studies who commit to working at the CISSS de la Côte-Nord for at least two years. Moreover, \$1,700 scholarships are offered by the vocational training centres in collaboration with the Commission des partenaires du marché du travail. Once they obtain their secondary school vocational diploma (SSVD), candidates will be able to have a job in the region.
