MEASURES TO FOLLOW REGARDING THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

Blanc-Sablon, March 20th, 2020 – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de la Côte-Nord wishes to inform the Lower North Shore population of certain measures to limit the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19). To this day, there are no confirmed case in the region.

The Lower North Shore residents are invited to call before going to a CLSC (clinic). This directive applies to all services: blood samples, appointments, emergencies, collecting medication from the community pharmacy, etc. Additionally, visits are prohibited in all of the CISSS de la Côte-Nord facilities, but humanitarian exceptions could be authorized for end-of-life care, perinatality or pediatrics, for example. It is also recommended that people aged 70 and over stay at home and only go out when necessary.

Other measures implemented by the government of Québec

- Self-isolation for 14 days for anyone who returned from a trip outside the country on March 12th, 2020 or after;
- Avoid all unnecessary interior public gatherings;
- Avoid unnecessary travel between regions;
- Closing of all schools and all childcare services.

In order to limit the spread of the virus, everyone must follow prevention measures:

- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water, or with an alcohol-based hand sanitizer;
- Cough and sneeze in your sleeve, or in a paper tissue that you then throw away;
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.
