VISITS AUTHORIZED IN CHSLD, PSR AND IR-FTR FOR SENIORS

Baie-Comeau, June 22nd, 2020 – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de la Côte-Nord announces that visits in residential and long-term care centres (CHSLD), private seniors' residences (PSR), intermediate resources (IR) and family-type resources (FTR) for seniors are now authorized. <u>Visits in hospitals will be authorized starting on June 26th, 2020.</u>

Visitors will not be allowed to enter the facility if:

- There is an outbreak in the environment;
- They have COVID-19 or they have been in close contact with a person who has COVID-19;
- They are waiting for the result of a COVID-19 test;
- They are in isolation;
- They have one of the following symptoms:
 - Body temperature over 38 °C or shivers;
 - Recent cough or exacerbated chronic cough;
 - Breathing difficulties;
 - o Loss of smell without nasal congestion, with or without loss of taste;
 - Global muscle pain (not related to physical effort);
 - Severe fatigue;
 - Important loss of appetite;
 - Sore throat;
 - Diarrhea or vomiting.

A caregiver or visitor who wishes to have a screening test can request it.

Instructions to follow

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, measures are put in place to ensure the safety of users, visitors and employees. Visitors (including volunteers, escorts and caregivers) must:

- Perform hand hygiene when entering and leaving the facility, and when entering and leaving the user's room;
- Correctly wear a procedure mask as soon as they enter the CHSLD, and keep it on for the whole visit;
- Adequately use the personal protective equipment (PPE);
- Go directly to the room of the person they are visiting;
- Stay two metres away from employees and users (including users they are visiting);
- Limit the transfer of objects from one place to another, for example, from their home to the CHSLD (clothes, handbags, lunch bag, documents, etc.);
- Visit with clean clothes, change clothes when they return home and wash these clothes (regular wash).

Maximum number of visitors for a user

- In IR-FTRs for seniors of 10 residents or less: a maximum of 10 people (caregivers or visitors) from three different households can visit a user while following the two-metre distancing rule.
- In IR-FTRs for seniors of 10 residents or more: a maximum of two people (caregivers or visitors) from a single household can visit a user while following the two-metre distancing rule.

 In PSRs: a maximum of 10 people (caregivers or visitors) from three different households can visit a user while following the two-metre distancing rule.

These measures are subject to change if an outbreak occurs in a facility.

Hospitals

When visits into hospitals are allowed again, <u>on June 26th</u>, the authorization criteria and the instructions will be the same as those detailed for visits into living environments (CHSLD, PSR, IR-FTR).

Until June 26th, only caregivers and escorts are allowed in hospitals. For more information, call before coming into the hospital:
