

VACCINATION OF YOUNG PEOPLE AGED 12 TO 17 YEARS OLD IN THE REGION

Baie-Comeau, May 28th, 2021 – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de la Côte-Nord announces the conditions of the COVID-19 vaccination for young people aged between 12 and 17 years old. Since vaccination will not take place in secondary schools, two options are possible:

- Make an appointment: Young people can register right now at quebec.ca/covidvaccine or by calling 1 877 644-4545. Vaccination centres are organized in every RCM in the region.
- Vaccination with their classroom group: Before the end of the school year, school transportation to a vaccination centre will be organized for their classroom group. Vaccination will take place during one school period. After vaccination, the classroom group will be brought back to school. The day of vaccination will be confirmed shortly.

For children aged 12 years and over who attend a primary school, we request that parents make an appointment with a vaccination centre at quebec.ca/covidvaccine or by calling 1 877 644-4545. The child must have reached the age of 12 at the time of vaccination.

Vaccination without appointment for the whole population

The CISSS de la Côte-Nord also wants to inform the population that every vaccination centre in the region now reserves time slots for vaccination without appointment, for everyone aged 12 years and over. The schedule will be published every week on the [website](#) of the CISSS de la Côte-Nord.
