

## THE NORTH SHORE RETURNS TO THE GREEN ALERT LEVEL

**Baie-Comeau, June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021** – Thanks to the considerable improvement of its epidemiological situation, the North Shore will return to the green alert level on June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

Let us remind you of the measures that apply in green alert level zones:

- Gatherings of up to 10 people, or of people from 3 households, are allowed in private homes, both indoors and outdoors. Wearing a mask and observing physical distancing are highly recommended.
- Ten people may also be at the same table in restaurants and bars (with some restrictions).
- Events and social gatherings in rented rooms or public places may receive up to 50 people outdoors (with physical distancing) and 25 people indoors (with physical distancing and masks).
- Sports and leisure activities (with short contacts) are allowed in groups of up to 50 people outdoors and up to 25 people indoors.

“Returning to the green alert level does not mean that all measures are lifted. Wearing a mask and observing two-metre physical distancing remain important until everyone has received their two doses of the vaccine, according to Dr. Richard Fachehoun, Public Health Director of the North Shore. I invite everyone aged 12 years and over to get vaccinated as soon as possible. Vaccination is the key to returning to a normal life!”
