

TEMPORARY SLOWDOWN OF CERTAIN ACTIVITIES ON JUNE 21ST AND 22ND, 2021

Baie-Comeau, June 18th, 2021 – Due to the strike planned for a portion of our employees on June 21st and 22nd, 2021, the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de la Côte-Nord wants to inform the population that certain services may be slowed down.

All essential care and services will be maintained during this strike, and access of users to the establishment must be guaranteed at all times. However, the waiting times may be longer, especially in sample collection centres (bloodwork and other prescribed sample collections), in medical imaging and when calling the call centre.

People who have an appointment on one of these two days and whose sample collection is not urgent can postpone their appointment to a later date. Users can manage their appointment online on [Clicsanté.ca](https://clicsante.ca) or by calling 1 833 704-0087. Please note that this service is provided on a walk-in basis at the Hôpital Le Royer.

We also want to inform you that June 24th and July 2nd are statutory holidays in every facility of the CISSS de la Côte-Nord. Sample collection centres and other health care services will be closed.
