

TEMPORARY CHANGES IN SERVICES FOR CERTAIN CLSCs

Baie-Comeau, September 22nd, 2021 – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de la Côte-Nord wants to inform the population that the services are temporarily modified in certain CLSCs of Minganie and Lower North Shore.

CLSC de Port-Menier

The CLSC de Port-Menier will be closed on Saturdays and Sundays from September 25th to October 10th, inclusively. The on-call nursing service remains available at any time of the day or night, seven days a week, when the CLSC is closed.

CLSC de Natashquan

Because of the absence of nursing staff on site during a few hours, the CLSC de Natashquan will be closed from 8:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. on September 27th, 2021.

During this period, residents of Natashquan who would need health care can go to the CLSC d'Aganish or the Centre multiservices de santé et de services sociaux de Havre-Saint-Pierre. They can also get advice by calling the Info-Santé 811 service, or 911 in case of an emergency.

CLSC de Chevery

The service reduction announced in August for the CLSC de Chevery is still effective until October 25th, inclusively. The only services offered currently are emergency services, palliative care, home care and pregnancy follow-ups.

At all times, residents of Chevery can call 811 to access the Info-Santé service. **In case of an emergency, the population must call the CLSC at 418 787-2277.**

Return to normal in La Tabatière and Saint-Augustin

The service reduction announced on August 6th for the CLSCs in La Tabatière and Saint-Augustin is over. The situation is now back to normal in these facilities.
