

## DISTRIBUTION OF RAPID TESTS IN THE CLSCs OF MINGANIE, LOWER NORTH SHORE AND SCHEFFERVILLE

**Baie-Comeau, January 28, 2022** – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de la Côte-Nord would like to notify the public that rapid tests are now available in the CLSCs of Minganie, Lower North Shore and Schefferville.

These rapid tests are distributed in communities that do not have access to tests provided by a pharmacy. To obtain them, you must first call your local CLSC to make an appointment Monday to Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. You can receive one box of five tests per person aged 14 and over.
