

## DO YOU LIVE IN BLANC-SABLON? ARE YOU INTERESTED IN THE PROJECT TO HOUSE SENIORS WITH A SLIGHT LOSS OF AUTONOMY?

**Blanc-Sablon, March 17, 2022** – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de la Côte-Nord is seeking a person to host two to three people in their living environment in Blanc-Sablon in order to provide them with daily support services required for their condition and their needs.

This kind of housing is a family-type resource (FTR). People who operate a FTR receive financial compensation for the services provided, established by the ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux. This compensation is indexed annually.

### Who can become an FTR?

Anyone who:

- is of legal age, living alone or with a family, who has a living environment (as a renter or an owner) with the potential to host users with a loss of autonomy;
- wishes to make a difference in these people's lives and is prepared to devote time and energy to such a project;
- is willing to offer a warm, stimulating, safe and peaceful environment;
- is willing to collaborate with CISSS de la Côte-Nord workers as well the users' families to support the user in their needs.
