

MANDATORY MASK AND REMOVAL OF DOOR ATTENDANTS AT THE ENTRANCES OF CISSS DE LA CÔTE-NORD FACILITIES

Baie-Comeau, May 13, 2022 – Even though wearing a mask will no longer be mandatory in public places as of May 14, 2022, the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de la Côte-Nord wants to remind the population that wearing a procedure mask or face covering remains mandatory at all times in certain facilities, including hospitals, multi-service health and social service centres, medical clinics, CLSCs and CHSLDs.

With the presence of influenza, COVID-19 and other viruses in the region, infection prevention and control measures must be followed for everyone's safety: use of the procedure mask or face covering, hand hygiene, physical distancing, etc. Moreover, no one with symptoms such as cough, fever, vomiting or diarrhea should visit our facilities.

End of the presence of door attendances at the entrances

Starting on Saturday, May 14, 2022, there will no longer be door attendants at the entrances of CISSS de la Côte-Nord facilities. Despite this change, infection prevention measures are still in effect. In addition to wearing a mask, users, visitors and family caregivers must wash their hands with the hydroalcoholic solution available at the entrances as soon as they arrive and when they leave.
