

RESTRICTION OF VISITS AT THE CENTRE MULTISERVICES DE SANTÉ ET DE SERVICES SOCIAUX DE LA BASSE-CÔTE-NORD

Baie-Comeau, May 25, 2023 – The Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de la Côte-Nord would like to inform the population of the Lower North Shore that visits are currently restricted on the short-term care unit of the Centre multiservices de santé et de services sociaux de la Basse-Côte-Nord in Blanc-Sablon, because of a COVID-19 outbreak.

Visits are only allowed for family caregivers (one at a time) or on compassionate grounds (e.g., person at the end of life). Family caregivers with signs of cough or fever should postpone their visit if possible. If the visit cannot be postponed, precautionary measures must be followed, including the use of a mask at all times.

For visits on compassionate grounds, precautionary measures must be applied, including isolation rules. Moreover, in order to protect users and staff, all employees are wearing a mask.

We remind you that handwashing (with hydroalcoholic solution or with soap and water) remains the best way to prevent COVID-19 transmission, and that no one with signs of cough or fever should visit our facilities.
