


Portrait of the Côte-Nord^{*}

- **Describe** certain characteristics of people experiencing homelessness from information collected through a questionnaire.


Estimated number of people experiencing homelessness: 94^b






Sources of income





Greatest challenges to overcome



Since 2018, a regional homelessness committee comprised of several partners, including community organizations, the CISSS de la Côte-Nord and local housing authorities, collaborates and commits to provide services to people who are experiencing homelessness or at risk of becoming homeless. Concerted efforts must continue.

Courses of action:

- Improve the emergency shelter offer in all regional county municipalities.
- Continue rolling out rent supplement programs by working with partners to improve accessibility to housing.
- Develop warming centres in communities of the region.
- Improve services offering food assistance and community fridges in communities of the region.
- Improve living conditions and continue the fight against poverty.
- Raise public awareness and understanding of homelessness.
