REPORT FROM PUBLIC HEALTH DIRECTOR ON HEALTH AND WELL-BEING OF NORTH SHORE POPULATION

The report from the Director of public health on the health and well-being of the North Shore population was presented by Dr. Stéphane Trépanier. It contains many regional data pertaining to lifestyle and chronic illnesses such as cancer and mental health issues, among others.

Specific sections are dedicated to the health of children and young people, the health of seniors as well as the health of workers. Courses of action are also suggested for some of the issues raised.

This portrait is intended for the North Shore population but also for the directors, decision-makers, elected officials, ministries and various professionals and workers of the health and social services network. It is also a tool to support the planning and programming of services to the public, including the priorities to focus on for a healthy population. ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT OF CISSS DE LA CÔTE-NORD

The Board of directors of the CISSS de la Côte-Nord adopted the 2017-2018 financial report.

Following the deposit of a \$13.9M one-time funding from the ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux (MSSS), the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de la Côte-Nord ends the 2017-2018 financial year with a surplus of \$351,916 (operations).

ASSESSMENT OF THE ACTION PLAN FOR DISABLED PERSONS

Following the adoption of the action plan for disabled persons, a monitoring committee was formed in order to ensure its implementation. This committee, composed of representatives from various departments of the CISSS de la Côte-Nord, met four times in 2017-2018.

Many actions were taken over the course of the year, such as:

- Merging the payroll data bases which will make it possible to generate the list of persons employed by the CISSS presenting functional limitations.
- Distributing the 2017-2018 action plan for the disabled to the entire personnel of the CISSS de la Côte-Nord.
- Establishing a guideline for the supply of goods and services for the disabled (ongoing).
- Taking steps to secure a unique tool that will make it possible to give an accurate view of the access to the different facilities of the institution.
- Reviewing the evacuation plans adapted to disabled persons (ongoing).

The action plan will be revised during the summer in order to continue its development.



“Each ministry or public organization that employs at least 50 employees and each municipality with 1,500 inhabitants must have a yearly action plan for disabled persons.”

COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS

For the 2018-2019 financial year, some 100 community organizations on the North Shore will receive funding from the community organizations support program (PSOC) amounting to \$11,527,885. The MSSS confirmed a 1.6% indexation rate for the funding granted to community organizations during the 2018-2019 financial year.

BOARD MEMBER RESIGNS

Mr. Carol Boies informed us on June 7 that he was no longer the president of the Fondation du Centre de santé de la Minganie. As a result, he cannot sit as an observing member and foundation representative on the Board of directors of the CISSS de la Côte-Nord. Steps will be taken in order to fill this position.
