## History

Following his accidental death in 1973, Dr. Camille Marcoux's parents and friends set up a foundation, aiming to perpetuate his generosity to the people of the Lower North Shore.

An initial fund of \$15,000 was gathered. Shortly after, the founding members dispersed, making it difficult for the Foundation to operate. Its activities really took off in 1979, when a Board of Directors was formed, with Lower North Shore residents.

In January 1995, the Doctor Camille-Marcoux Foundation broadened its role by becoming the official foundation of the Centre de santé et de services sociaux de la Basse-Côte-Nord. Thereafter it had a social health role in addition to encouraging students through scholarship grants.

Since then, a number of scholarships, varying from \$300 to \$750 each, have been awarded to Lower North Shore students. The Foundation has also provided equipment contributing to better health care for the users of the Lower North Shore.

## The Foundation's Objectives

The primary objective of the Foundation is developing education and social health on the Lower North Shore. Specifically, its mission is to:

- Support the development of human resources on the Lower North Shore by awarding scholarship grants in recognition academic perseverance;
- Support the Point de service de la Basse-Côte-Nord, part of the CISSCN, in its projects aimed at improving services;
- Obtain, for the purposes mentioned above, funds and other assets through subscriptions or donations;
- Receive donations, legacies or other similar contributions as money, securities or real estate, manage these contributions as well as organize subscription drives, all in pursuit of the above-mentioned objectives.

*Note that students are eligible to one bursary granted by the Foundation per school year.*

## Bursary Request

Bursary eligibility requirements:

- Be a resident of the Lower North Shore (Kegaska to Blanc-Sablon);
- Be a member or have a parent/tutor that is a member of the Foundation;
- Be registered as a full-time student;
- Pursue vocational (uninterrupted), college or university studies at a recognized educational institution.

You must include the following in your bursary application :

- Application form;
- Presentation letter;
- Official confirmation of registration and attendance from an educational institution;
- Official copy of your educational transcript issued by the institution which you are attending.

## Selection criteria

A selection committee from the Commission scolaire du Littoral will select candidates based on the following criteria:

- Demonstration of academic perseverance;
- Relevance of the application;
- Analysis of the presentation letter (quality of language and clarity).
